California Proposition 65: Safe Drinking and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986

Statement of XL Precision Technologies Compliance with California Proposition 65

OEHHA updated the toxicity of substances on the California Proposition 65 substance list most recently on the 29th December 2023.

California Proposition 65 requires clear and reasonable warnings on products containing any of the chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm over a safe harbour level.

Certain products manufactured by XL Precision Technologies can present a low risk of exposure in chemicals which are known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm; these metals being Chromium and Nickel, both of which are only found in traceable forms and are not found in measurable quantities.

These products, when used and disposed of in the intended, correct and foreseeable manner, do not pose any significant exposure or risk to human health.
